- ✓ Protecting our natural heritage is a task our government will deliver with the focus, ambition, and strategy it deserves.
- ✓ Building climate resilience is economically smart, fiscally responsible, and essential to protecting Canadians and the places they call home. Here's what Canada's new government is doing.

- ✓ Expanding electric vehicle charging across the country through the **National Charging Infrastructure Strategy**.



- ✓ Offering up to **\$5,000 to Canadians** to purchase or lease a light-duty zero-emission vehicle.



Through the Climate Competitiveness Strategy, we are driving down emissions, providing certainty to industry through clear regulations, investing in clean energy, innovation, and technology all while creating good clean jobs of the future.

A strong industrial carbon pricing system is one of our most effective tools to reduce our emissions and fight climate change.

Our government has finalized enhanced methane regulations for the oil and gas sector and landfills which will result in **400 Mt of emissions reductions** from 2026-2040.

Worked hand-in-hand with provinces to secure **co-operation agreements** with New Brunswick, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, Nova Scotia, Manitoba, and Alberta, building on the success of the agreement with British Columbia that's been in place since 2019.

Implementing

A FORCE OF NATURE:

Canada's Strategy to Protect Nature, a plan that:

- ✓ Works to **preserve 30% of Canada's lands and waters** by 2030.
- ✓ Includes an initial **\$3.8 billion investment** to execute the plan.
- ✓ Providing **\$160 million to protect whales** and their habitat via the Spring Economic Update 2026.
- ✓ Developing Canada's first-ever **National Water Security Strategy**.
